

The consequences of falling from a height can be so great that Regulation specifies requirements must be observed to protect persons *working at heights* from this risk. In particular, Clause 56(1)(a) of the OH&S Regulation 2001 sets out a hierarchy of controls that must be observed. Failure to observe these controls can lead to prosecution under OH&S legislation.
