Fire Assure Fire-Rated Lining Systems (Wall & Ceiling Lining)

This is a new version of the course set up last year. After extensive research and development it is been redesigned to suit the needs of the market, making it more accessible to more people in the industry.

Certificate IV BCGBC4047A as it is officially known, is an accredited course that runs for one and a half days of training and a live work assignment that will need to be handed in for assessment within twelve weeks for completion of the course.

The course covers the inspection and signing off process of fire rated lining systems, which is compulsory in most other states. At this stage, here in Victoria we as a trade do not have registration and there is no requirement to fill out certificate 16 BSA forms for compliance. But you can take it from me, it won't be long. As it is, some sub-contractors are being asked to sign compliance certificates for the head contractor or building inspector, a 'very dangerous' situation. You need to know a little more than to simply trust your installers, and that's where this course comes in. We cover the aspects of installation, inspection and evidence process for compliance, and in doing so successful participants achieve a Certificate IV in quality assured fire rated lining systems which is mandatory for registration in other States of Australia. Students must have a Certificate III or a trade qualification or equivalent, to sit the certificate IV course.
